Klaus von Stosch is Professor of Catholic Theology and its Didactics at the University of Paderborn.

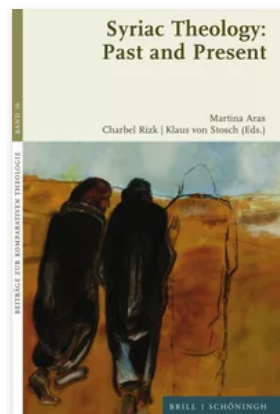
